Please apply with an abstract (approx. 800 words) in which you present a) the problem or question at hand, b) its relevance and context, be it institutional, scientific or political, c) its audience(s), d) your approach and, if available, e) the results and conclusions. Your presentations are scheduled to last 15 minutes + 15 minutes of discussion.

Submission deadline: May 3, 2024, in German or English to rehes2024@chess.uzh.ch.

We will inform you about the selection decision by the start of June 2024.
